1. Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance: Eric Buffkin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

5. New business
 - a. Appointment of Secretary – The booster club elected Wendy Sheehan as this year's Secretary.

Perhaps build a network for future communication between existing cadets and alumni: i.e. establish mentoring, invited guests to speak. It was decided that the booster club

- c. Upcoming drill meet – October 12, Valdosta, GA. There will be 50 cadets (10 teams) participating in this first drill meet. Teams will be announced tomorrow. A schedule of the drill meet will be sent out via email, letter and our website with information to the cadets and parents. There will be a \$10.00 fee per cadet and the cadet will be responsible for purchasing their own food at the meet.
 - d. Next week – cadets will not wear their uniform to school. They will wear their PT gear. Garment bags and black polos will be distributed for those cadets participating. Uniforms will be brought to school to prepare for the drill meet. Cadets will be told not to wear their JRTOC provided jacket to the meet.
 - e. Upcoming field day / adopt a highway – October 25th. 6 adult volunteers will be needed starting roughly at 9:45 am and ending at approximately 12:00. Adult drivers to provide transportation back from adopt a highway project to the school and helping set up lunch will be needed.
 - f. October 30 – Both individual and group photos will be taken at school.
 - g. The possibility of a Dining-In Social and Dinner in the spring was discussed. Dining-In is a formal dinner held by a military unit or organization.
