### Meeting Minutes – March 11, 2014

1. Call to order and Pledge of Allegiance: Eric Buffkin called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. Approval of Meeting Minutes – Minutes from the February, 2014 booster club were approved with a minor change under 5a. The name of the end of the year trip was changed McDill.
3. Financial Report – Copy attached to these minutes. ROTC breakfast fundraising report was presented. Treasurer will look into the \$5.00 account analysis fee with the bank.
  - a. Award Rock – a purchase of 6 rocks will be made for cadet of the quarter awards.
4. Old business –
  - a. Haile & Farewell – Tuesday, May 6<sup>th</sup>. Start time will be 6:30 p.m. Only medals will be presented. Other awards will be done during school. There will be a 15 minute break, and the Colonel Griggs event will start at 7:45 pm. After the Haile & Fairewell, there will be a reception in the cafeteria of cake, finger foods, chips, and drinks. This event will be advertised on the website.
    - i. Gifts: Purchases were approved for a \$150.00 gift certificate to Lt. Colonel Grigg's spouse. \$200.00 for a shadow box and helmet were approved for a gift to Lt. Colonel Grigg.

- b. Award Rock: A purchase of 6 rocks will be presented to Cadets of the Quarter. Rocks are \$50.00 each.

5. New business

- a. Cat Madness – An Internal drill meet is scheduled for Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 – 2:30 p.m. They might need some help picking up food, etc.
- b. Summer Leadership Camp this summer – Based on Chief Price's appointment being lowered from a 12 month to an 11 month, they will not be able to do a 5 day summer camp. Chief Price suggested that they take the top 14, incoming executive staff offsite in June for 1-2 nights at Camp Kulaqua. It would be roughly \$200.00 + food per night. Then, there would be a 2 day – day camp for all ROTC members the week before school. Monday would be uniform distribution and Tuesday would be a field day.
- c. Banners for seniors – Chief Price suggested that banners be printed for all ROTC seniors to be displayed at the awards banquet and given to the seniors to keep. Fees are approximately \$25.00 set up fee and then \$38.00 per banner. This year there are approximately 12-15 seniors. A \$500.00 purchase was approved for these banners. A sliding scale would be used to charge cadets for the banners:
  - i. 4th year cadets – no charge
  - ii. 3rd year cadets - \$10.00
  - iii. 2nd year cadets - \$20.00
  - iv. 1st year cadets - \$30.00
