Typically, the costs for the SLS run \$5,000, and the fees per cadet are ~\$65.00 each. There will be an estimated private donation of \$3,000-\$5,000 by the Islam family to offset these fees. The new officers will meet with Chief Price next week to discuss the final estimate of all costs involved and a salary stipend by the board.
